Short breaks at Kites Rise

This is a specific short break provision for young adults with learning disabilities, between the ages of 18 and 30.

The property is situated in its own grounds, on an elevated site with views onto open countryside from all rooms in **rural west Gateshead**, close to local shops and amenities and only a 15 minute drive from Gateshead Metro Centre and 20 from Newcastle Central Station.

Kites Rise is a **vibrant but homely environment for up to 4 young adults** to develop the skills they need to live independently, enjoy social opportunities and spend time with their peers, thus giving their carer a much needed break.

We aim to facilitate friendship groups, support transition planning and provide a stepping stone towards supported living.

We're flexible - It's about what you need to help you in your caring role. Our person centered approach ensures that both you as a carer and the young person you support are the focus of the service provided.

Kites Rise is staffed by our Carer Support Workers who are trained to **NVQ level 2 or 3 in Health and Social Care** and checked by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). Clients will be encouraged by our staff to access appropriate activities of their choice and be supported with practical, personal and specialized care as needed.

Accessing Kites Rise

If the person you care for is eligible for support and has a respite allocation you can choose to come to Kites Rise using your **Direct Payment**.

Costs per night (available on request) cover 24 hour support, meals and activities. Individual 1:1 support is available if required, subject to risk assessment.
